Tourism funds and supports the majority of AfriCat's Education & Conservation work.





### OKONJIMA

Okonjima - home of AfriCat, a non-profit organisation, committed to long-term conservation of Namibia's large carnivores. Okonjima's 200km<sup>2</sup> / 22000 ha private Nature Reserve - hosts 4 Lodges and 4 private camp-sites, accommodation for any budget! Check for specials on our website.

Okonjima is half-way between Windhoek and Etosha National Park (2 hours drive North of Windhoek - BI). A 20 min. gravel road through our private, Nature Reserve - is part of the experience.

Okonjima Lodge activities include:

- Tracking Leopards from a game-view vehicle.
- Track rehabilitated Cheetah or Spotted Hyaena or Wild Dog on foot.
- Unguided walking trails / Bushman trail / birding trails on request.
- Visit AfriCat's Carnivore Care and Information Centre. (meet some of our ambassador cheetahs)







#### AFRICAT DAY CENTRE

Visitors will be able to observe some of AfriCat's work and learn more about these endangered, amazing and beautiful animals.

YOUR VISIT TO AfriCat WILL INCLUDE: A short, guided-drive to the AfriCat Carnivore Care and Information Centre to meet some of our species ambassadors.

Activities are on offer twice daily, please check departure times on making your booking. Enjoy a cool drink and light lunch with your family.

## OKONJIMA'S OMBOROKO CAMPSITE

- Hot water shower/s and flushing toilet/s.
- A washing-up area under a roof.
- A viewpoint and camp sites share a secluded swimming-pool.
- 2 bundles of fire wood supplied.
- I fixed light per campsite for cooking & I plug point available for charging.
- Due to the nature of our activities, child participation is restricted. No children under the age of 4 allowed on activities.
- Rate includes: camp site and one guided activity to AfriCat's Carnivore Care and Information Centre .
- No tents, drinks or meals are provided by Okonjima Lodge!
- None of the Lodge facilities are open or available to campers.
- Curio-shop and light lunches are available at the AfriCat Day Centre.
- In low season dinner and additional activities can be PRE-BOOKED at the lodge if lodges have space!
